**Instructions to Senior High School applicants seeking the Marjorie Kirk Ullrich scholarship:**

Scholarship grants are based on demonstrated talent and motivation in the fine arts, academic achievement, fullness of character, and need. Grants will be paid directly to the college or university after the applicant has successfully completed one semester of matriculation and has enrolled for a second semester.

The deadline for applications is **March 1** of each calendar year. Once the application is received, the Foundation will schedule an interview with the applicant. Applicants will be notified of the Foundation's decision by June 1.

To apply for a scholarship:

1. You must be a Killingworth resident.
2. You must currently be enrolled as a full-time high school student at Haddam-Killingworth High School.
3. You must have a cumulative high school grade point average equivalent to a "B" or higher at the time of application.
4. You must be applying to a post-secondary educational institution.

Please submit:

1. The Foundation's application, including the required hand-written essay. Please be advised that everything counts on your application: neatness, legibility, spelling, grammar, and providing the information as requested are important.
2. An official transcript from Haddam-Killingworth High School, including SAT and/or ACT scores. Please have your transcript sent directly to the Foundation from the Haddam-Killingworth High School Guidance Department
3. Please be prepared to submit a sample of your work or a demonstration of your talent during the interview.
